

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Bookkeeping That Works


- GAAP = Generally Accepted Accounting Principals
- Too many churches try to simplify only to complicate.



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Bookkeeping That Works


- Create Clear Policies & Procedures
 - My Two Rules:
 - Follow The Money
 - Keep It Simple



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Bookkeeping That Works

Policy:
 A policy is a guiding principle used to set direction in an congregation. It can be a course of action to guide and influence decisions. It should be used as a guide to decision making under a given set of circumstances within the framework of objectives, goals and management philosophies as determined by the church council.




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Policy:
Like a "mini-mission statement"


- User
- Purpose
- Measures



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Procedure:
A procedure is a particular way of accomplishing something. It should be designed as a series of steps to be followed as a consistent and repetitive approach or cycle to accomplish an end result. Once complete, you will have a set of established methods for conducting the business of your congregation, which will come in handy for training, process auditing, process improvement, or compliance initiatives.



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Bookkeeping That Works

The Difference:
A policy is a guiding principle used to set direction in an organization. A procedure is a series of steps to be followed as a consistent and repetitive approach to accomplish an end result. Together they are used to empower the people responsible for a process with the direction and consistency they need for successful process improvement.



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The Difference:

Policies are meant to remain static: they are mission-oriented rules or terms that often describe what and why.

In contrast, procedures are narrow in focus. Procedures aim to describe how, when, and who of processes.



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Trust The System!

- When we build solid policies and procedures, we can trust the system to protect us.
- We aren't reliant on trusting individuals.
- When we deviate from trusting the system, we invite issues.

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Segregation of Duties


» primary internal controls intended to prevent or decrease the risk of errors, identify problems, and ensure corrective action is taken.



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Segregation of Duties

Segregation of Duties are primary internal controls intended to prevent or decrease the risk of errors, identify problems, and ensure corrective action is taken. This is accomplished by ensuring that no single individual has control over all phases of any business transaction. There are four general categories of duties:




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Segregation of Duties

There are four general categories of duties:


Authorization	Custody	Record Keeping	Reconciliation
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Authorization


- › Who has authorization to approve expenses?
- › Is this clearly defined for everyone in process?
- › Is the established process requiring documentation of authorization?
- › Is the established process followed?



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Custody

- › Who has physical possession of checks?
- › Are they signed out?
- › Who has been given signature authority of checking and investment accounts?
- › Who has keys/combination to the safe?
- › PayPal, Online Contributions, Bill Pay...



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Record Keeping

- Who has access to the accounting system?
- Is the accounting system password protected?
- Who can audit it?



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Reconciliation

- Who performs the bank reconciliation for your bank and investment accounts?
- Who receives the bank statements?
- How do you reconcile what the counters provide the bookkeeper?
